## General Expectations

This is an independent contractor position. Upon completion of the onboarding process, you will be given a caseload of up to four (4) clients to start, with the possibility of more after the first two months. Depending on the needs of each client and the training process, your hours will range between four and a half to six per week, on average 18, per month. When an SST client is assigned to you, you are committed to provide service according to the signed agreement and treatment plan between the client and SST. As an SST independent contractor, you must adhere to our policies and procedures for taking leave in order to not adversely affect the client's progress. The salary will be determined by your experience and qualifications, and is negotiable. There are no additional benefits. We are offering a one (1) year contract with the possibility of extension.
